1. Membership and Growth:

- Although several new members joined our organisation during the last year, membership numbers remain a concern. There is strength in numbers therefore membership growth will remain a focus in the next few years.
- We encourage members to assist in this effort and invite non-members to join us in making Durbanville GREAT.

2. Functions and Networking:

- Our quarterly functions facilitated valuable connections and collaborations. Networking opportunities at these events remain a top priority.
- The February function was a historic highlight for Durbanville Business, with a record number of attendees. Despite the challenges of hosting it in the Durbanville Townhall, we agree to use this venue again in the future.
- We are also planning our first women's event this year, with preparations underway.
